

Selection terms and process

Eligibility Requirements

The Co-opholdings Regional Delegates meeting, which is the selection Committee is looking for candidates who meet the following eligibility requirements: -

- a. Student must have qualified with a **minimum of 350 points** in the standard eight final examinations.
- b. Student must be from a **needy family** that is unable to support secondary education.
- c. At least one of the parents of the student must be/have been a member of a co-operative society.
- d. Orphans will be eligible provided at least one of the deceased parents was a member of a co-operative society.
- e. The applicant **MUST** be from a public day primary school. Applicants from private schools and public boarding schools shall not be considered for this sponsorship programme.
- f. Parents/guardians with regular source of income will be reviewed based on the **GROSS** salary and not **NET** salary

Terms of the Sponsorship

The award is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- The sponsorship will be extended to 60 students per Region
- Not more than two thirds $\frac{2}{3}$ of either gender should be selected for the award per region.
- The applicant must provide the foundation with all the requested information for review prior to the awarding of the scholarship
- The scholarship will cover school fees, uniforms, and books upto a maximum of Kshs. 95,000 per year for national schools and Kshs. 65,000 for all other schools. Priority will be given to payment of school fees based on the indicated limits.
- The sponsorship will cover fees for the entire secondary education, i.e. from Form One to Form Four.
- School fees will be payable directly to the school and to the suppliers in case of books and uniforms.
- The sponsorship will be conditional upon the sponsored student maintaining consistent good performance, discipline and conduct in the four years of Secondary Education.
- Relatives of Co-operative Bank employees, Co-opholdings, Co-opholdings Delegates and Directors are excluded from participation in this programme.
- The Co-operative Bank Foundation reserves the right to award the sponsorship, review the conditions and procedures of the scholarship program and to make changes at any time and without giving notice to applicant, parents and their guardians.
